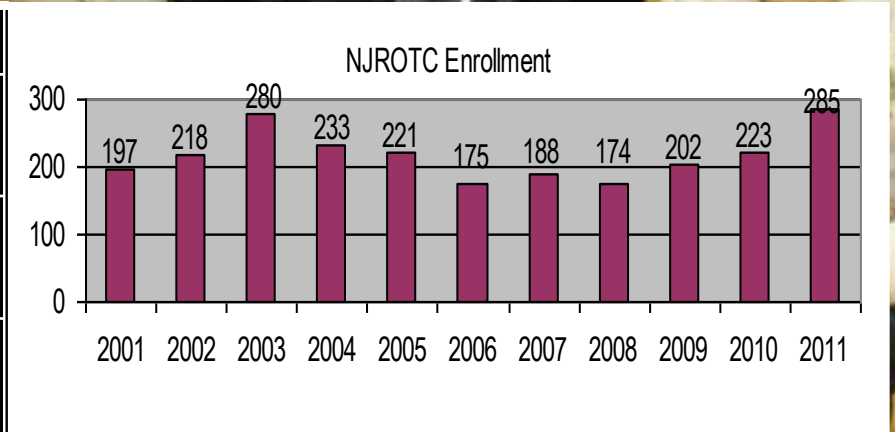

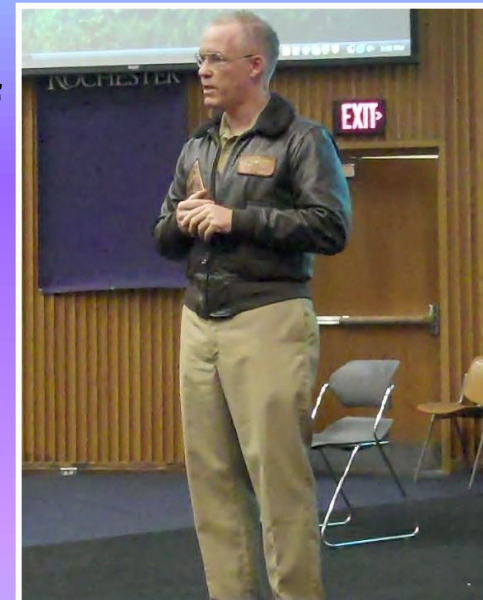


University Visits and Admiral Quinn Presentation—Rochester, RIT & Syracuse

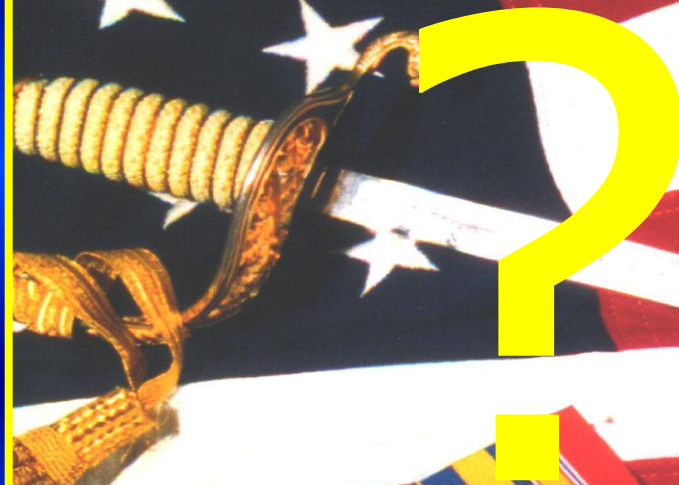


LT GEN RICHARD T. SWOPE SCHOLARSHIP
