Rome Lab and Griffiss Airport

On Monday, I had the opportunity to meet with the CNY Defense Alliance, a local organization that is dedicated to promoting, strengthening and expanding the region's Department of Defense operations. We discussed their important advocacy and work with Rome Lab, the FAA test site, Griffiss Airport and other local businesses in Griffiss Park.

After we met with the CNY Defense Alliance, I joined Rome Mayor Jackie Izzo and Director Daniel Goddard to tour the Air Force Research Laboratory Information Directorate in Rome. We had the opportunity to speak with Rome Lab employees to discuss the many ways their facility is leading in advanced research and development critical to enhancing our war fighters and our cyber defense.

Following the tour, we visited NUAIR's facility at Griffiss International Airport to see the ways their facility is using the FAA test site to develop and test state of the art unmanned aerial vehicles and systems. We also visited AX Enterprize to speak with their staff about their partnership with Griffiss Airport and working alongside NUAIR to further enhance cutting-edge cyber and UAV technologies.
