VA ROME COMMUNITY-BASED OUTPATIENT CLINIC Director Bill Hamelin

Due to the virus pandemic, volunteers were not permitted to operate within the VA from 16 March 2020 through 01 September 2020. However, from 01 January 2020 through 15 March 2020, our volunteers assisted 96 veterans and provided 428 volunteer hours at the Rome Donald J. Mitchel VA clinic. We're pleased to report that volunteer services have resumed, although slowly. Our volunteers provide the required in-person authentications, and can now use VA Video Connect services and telephone services to authenticate veterans remotely. Due to the clinic operating on a "limited" access methodology to prevent overcrowding; entry into the clinic has been modified as follows: when a veteran has an appointment, they are not allowed to enter the facility until 15 mins. prior to that appointment. Masks must be worn at all times, and temperatures are taken upon entry. There are a few quick screening questions that are asked to complete the process. No one is allowed to accompany a veteran to their appointment unless it is medically required to provide assistance to that veteran during their visit. All immunizations are provided to veterans in the main parking lot (signs are posted directing to the immunization point). Flu shots will begin on 01 October 2020. Audiology support is now available at the clinic to perform minor repairs twice a week; an appointment is required.

VA RED COAT AMBASSADOR PROGRAM

The VA Red Coat Ambassador program is a special volunteer program instituted at the Syracuse VA Medical Center and its associated Primary Care clinics. This program allows volunteers to assist veterans with specialized computer programs, such as Myhealthevet and Ebenefits.

Myhealthevet allows veterans the ability to access, interact, and view their medical information, which includes lab test results, prescription ordering and tracking, medical imaging, communicating with their primary care team, and making in-person and video connect appointments. It also accepts veteran input on a variety of health-related items like weight, blood pressure, medical treatment from outside the VA and OTC medications.

Ebenefits is a program that allows veterans to access their disability information, make an application for benefits, track compensation exam results, apply for VA loan certificate, track compensation payments, appeals, and many others.

These volunteers receive specialized training with these programs to assist veterans with enrollment and usage of these programs.

Red Coat Ambassadors also act as Ombudsman for the veteran when they visit or contact the VA clinic with an issue. They assist the veteran by ensuring they are routed to the proper office or representative for swift and efficient response to the issue presented. Any issues faced by the veteran that cannot be resolved by the Red Coat Ambassador, can then be escalated to the immediate attention of the clinic Nurse Manager for resolution. This methodology has greatly reduced the frustration and delay sometimes encountered by veterans navigating through the VA.

VETERAN USE OF URGENT CARE FACILITIES APPROVED

As part of the VA MISSION ACT of 2018, Veterans who have received medical care from the VA, or VA sponsored community providers, anytime during the last 24 months are

now eligible to utilize URGENT CARE. If you are in Priority Group 1~5, the first 3 visits in a year are free, and after that there is a \$30 co-pay for each visit. Priority Groups 6~8 will incur co-payments of \$30 for each visit. Locations are available throughout NY state (and US). If the veteran encounters problems, call 866-620-2071 for assistance.

DOD TRAVEL INFORMATION

The Department of Defense has established an official DOD sponsored/sanctioned web page that retirees can access for reduced prices with air flights, hotels, etc. The **American Forces Travel** page is located at this address:

After you select your hotel, flight, etc., and before it lets you proceed further, it will ask for some information to verify your eligibility. Once your eligibility has been approved it will allow you to proceed. DOD has a contract through Priceline to provide discounts for military personnel and retirees.

OPTICAL SERVICES THROUGH THE VA

Do You Wear Glasses? Need a new set of frames & lenses....do you get your glasses from the VA? They should provide them for you at (normally) no cost. Stop at the Rome clinic to find out if you are eligible through the VA. Also, Ft. Drum Medical will provide hearing aids to retirees and spouse at COST.
